BALKAN TOUR

The Balkan Tour is open to all nations, Equestrian Federations of which are members of FEI, of which their national territory is totally or partially situated within the Balkan Peninsula and their Equestrian Federations have accepted the provisions of the present special regulations and have paid the organizing fee.

The athletes who their NF's did not contribute to the organising fee, can compete in the Competition No:20, Big Tour Grand Prix without getting point for the Balkan Tour.

The Events are open by invitation to National Federations which did not contribute to the organising fee or lay outside the Balkan Region. Athletes from these Federations have no right to obtain points for the final classification.

The horse nominated for the BT competition or having been ridden in the BT competition at an event may not compete in another competition on that day, neither before nor after the BT competition.

A rider can ride more than one horse in the BT competitions. In such case, the horse going for BT points has to be declared before the start of the competition, and the competitor must ride this horse first. Once the competition has begun, a competitor may not change his BT horse. However, prior to the beginning of the competition a competitor may change his BT horse only if his originally declared BT horse is scratched from the competition and the newly declared BT horse competes in the same position in the starting order as his originally declared BT horse.

SIEC – FEI WORLD YOUTH SERIES

The SIEC FEI World Youth Series is for riders between ages of 12 and 21. Team Competition Class No: 9 is restricted to teams representing NF who have participated fully in the qualification requirements in their own countries. Invited NF's who have not met the requirement of qualification criteria may compete Hours Councour in the Competition Class No:9.

The hotel rooms will be reserved by the Organising Committee. Costs will be paid for a maximum of five nights, from Wednesday 16th September, 2009 until Monday September 21st, 2009. A longer stay will be at the expense of those concerned. Officials staying in a hotel other than the one selected by the Organising Committee, will have to pay all expenses incurred themselves.

2. ATHLETES

(SIEC-FEI World Youth Series Team Riders Only)

Hotel accommodation and meals will be paid by the Organising Committee for SIEC-FEI World Youth Series team riders. (extra's: telephone, charges for the use of the internet, beverages, drinks etc. not included).

The hotel rooms will be reserved by the Organising Committee. Costs will be paid for a maximum of five nights, from Wednesday 16th September, 2009 until Monday September 21st, 2009. A longer stay will be at the expense of those concerned. Athletes staying in a hotel other than the one selected by the Organising Committee, will have to pay all expenses incurred themselves.

3. GROOMS (SIEC-FEI World Youth Series Team Grooms Only)

Hotel accommodation and meals of the SIEC-FEI World Youth Series Team Grooms (maximum 2 groom/driver per NF) will be paid by the Organising Committee. (Extra's: telephone, charges for the use of the internet, beverages, drinks etc. not included). Costs will be paid for a maximum of five nights, from Wednesday 16th September, 2009 until Monday September 21st ; a longer stay will be at the expense of those concerned. The Organising Committee will provide sufficient clean sanitary and showering facilities, with hot and cold water, for male and female grooms.

4. HORSES

All horses entered for the CSI2* must be 6 or more years old. Accommodation for the horses will be available for home and foreign athletes in temporary stables from Tuesday September 15th, 2009 / 09hrs00 am for the entire duration of the event, on through Monday September 21st, 2009 / 12hrs00 pm. Exact dimensions of stables: 3 m. x 3 m. Since stabling is limited, basically there are no stable for horses that do not participate in the CSI2* 2009. However, if the OC approves in advance the stabling of an extra horse, an amount of € 300, - (Euro) per horse will be charged for each horse not competing in CSI2* 2009. All the transport expenses to be paid by the athletes themselves; there will be no reimbursement of travelling expenses by the Organising Committee. Only the transportation of the horses participating to the SIEC-FEI World Youth Series will be paid by the OC under the agreements with their NF.

NO SMOKING in the stables. It is forbidden to smoke in the stable area. The Ground Jury and/or the Chief Steward can sanction infringement by definite banning out of the stable area and/or a fine of up to € 650, - (Euro)

5.CHEF D'EQUIPES (SIEC-FEI World Youth Series Team Chef D'Equipes Only)

All Chef d'Equipes must attend to the technical meeting on September 16th, 2009 / One hour after the end of the Vet Check. Chef d'equipes are the guest of the Organising Committee; hotel accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner will be paid by the Organising Committee (extra's: telephone, charges for the use of the internet, beverages, drinks etc. not included).

The hotel rooms will be reserved by the Organising Committee. Costs will be paid for a maximum of five nights, from Wednesday 16th September, 2009 until Monday September 21st, 2009. A longer stay will be at the expense of those concerned. Chef d'equipes staying in a hotel other than the one selected by the Organising Committee, will have to pay all expenses incurred themselves.

BALKAN TOUR POINTS

Number of competitors awarded points.

BT points are awarded to competitors only (not to competitor/horse combination) for each BT competition. Points are awarded to the 16 best placed competitors of the BT (disregarding the competitors not in the BT).

Equality of points

Points won by competitors who are tied are added and divided equally. Fractions of 0.5 or more are rounded up; fractions of less than 0.5 are rounded down.

Competitions with less than sixteen competitors

If there are less than 16 competitors starting the initial course of a BT competition, the scale of points will be reduced accordingly. Only Athletes who have completed the initial round will get points.

Athletes and horses placed must attend the prize giving ceremony. The numbers 1 up to and including 5 must present themselves for the prize-giving ceremony of each. However, for the Grand Prix of Istanbul all riders placed in this competition will be invited to attend the prize giving ceremony with their placed horses. The owner of the winning horse is invited to the prize giving ceremony for the Grand Prix as well.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**
